Location

We are a drive in "Outpost" Resort located 140 miles northwest of Thunder Bay, Ontario (just north of Upsala, Ontario). We are located in one of the most productive areas in NW Ontario with numerous other lakes also available by road for the novice or experienced angler. Thunder Bay is the closest airport. Guests wanting to fly into Thunder Bay, can rent a vehicle for the week and drive up to the lodge. The convenience of having your own vehicle for wildlife viewing alone will make it all worthwhile.

The Lake/Fishing

Wawang Lake Resort is ranked #1 for trophy sized walleye & northern in Ontario by OFAH. Wawang Lake itself is 5,000 acres with over 75 miles of irregular shoreline which offers the fisherman exciting fish habitat to explore, such as sand bars, shoals, weed beds and islands - perfect for exciting fishing. Our lake is easy to navigate and offers 1,500' of natural white sand beach with gradual incline which is perfect for swimming. Wawang also has many remote beaches for complete privacy during a swim or a traditional shore lunch. Our lake is internationally known internationally for trophy walleye and pike but is also home to whitefish & perch. Fishing remains consistent throughout the season for numbers of fish & for those monster northern pike.

Hunting

Hunt for black bear, wolf and grouse. We also cater to Ontario resident moose hunters as well. The area around our resort has long been considered one of Ontario's best moose and bear hunting locations. Since we are the onlylodge for miles and miles, the wildlife remains abundant and undisturbed in its natural habitat. The multi-system of animal trails and logging road makes it appealing for all types of hunting.



Things to Remember to Bring

- Bring your own tree stand as we do not provide them. Comfortable stands such as 'ladders' are most
 preferred by most of our hunters, however, whatever you choose remember that our trees can be very
 limby and have very loose bark. Self climbers are not recommended however, screw in pegs are legal.
- Your weapon of choice with case, and extra ammunition
- Camo clothing (quiet & scent free) Rain gear, Head Net, Assortment of clothing for variety of weather conditions
- DO NOT bring brand new leather boots. Older ones that have been aired for several weeks are better.
- Flashlight Flagging Tape Compass or GPS (know how to use it!)
- Unscented soaps, shampoo's and bug repellent a MUST! (No Thermocells on stands!)
- Blaze orange hat & vest (required by law to be worn to and from the bait site)
- Old or current state hunting license to show Ontario issuer as proof of hunting experience.

Grouse Hunting

Resort Season: September 15th to Oct 31st

Grouse hunting is a relaxing pastime that is getting more and more popular every year. What can be more rewarding than taking a long walk on a cool fall day and wandering through the wilderness and enjoying the fall foliage? The clean air and exercise combined with the thrill of the hunt makes for the most enjoyable

vacation.

The region around Wawang Lake is a system of animal trails, ATV trails and old logging roads where you can explore miles and miles of wilderness, that is just stuffed with grouse. You can also combine your grouse hunting with our excellent fishing, or, another hunt.

There are three species of grouse found in Ontario. Ruffed Grouse, Spruce Grouse and the Sharptail Grouse. Ruffed Grouse is the most common and comprise 80% of what you will encounter during your hunt.

The limit for grouse in Ontario is 5 per day in any combination of species with a total of 15 in your possession and you will be surprised at the number of grouse we do have. Their cycle consistently remains to stay high.

The most popular guns for grouse hunting are .410 or 20 gauge shot gun and some nunters use a 12 gauge as well. Quickly becoming more and more popular is hunting grouse with a bow. To increase the excitement give a bow a try & the challenge is sure to thrill you. Solid hunter orange is required if you're hunting during the big game rifle season.






We are remote and that means keep those cameras handy for some incredible wildlife such as bear, moose, caribou, wolf, lynx, otter, beaver, martin, fox, etc.

HOW TO REACH US

Follow hwy 17 west from Thunder Bay, Ontario for approximately 100 miles, turn north (right) on the Graham Rd, proceed to km 50 marker, turn left and continue for six (6) more miles.





IMPORTANT THINGS TO REMEMBER

For Fishermen:

Fishing licenses, life preservers, landing nets, minnow buckets, leech containers, night-crawlers (in commercial bedding for atleast 15 days must be accommodated with receipt as proof), fully stocked tackle box, bug repellent, camera (film if required)batteries, flashlight, warm clothing, gloves/hat/boots, soap, deodorant, shampoo, tooth brush and tooth paste, head nets, and bedding if on the Housekeeping Plan. Bring your own gas BBQ grill.

For Hunters:

Hunting license as proof of hunting experience (mandatory), gun registration forms (3) to be completely filled out prior to your arrival at the Canadian Border, BUT do not sign unless in the presence of acustoms officer. Treestand, safety harnesses, hunting gear, rifle and/or bow, ammunition, bug repellent, head net, blaze orange clothing, warm clothing/gloves/boots/hat, unscented soap, deodorant, shampoo, tooth brush and tooth paste, towels, life preservers, camera (film if required), batteries, flashlight, and bedding if on the Housekeeping Plan. Bring your own barbeque grill. IMPORTANT: Pick up your hunting & fishing licenses before arriving at the resort.
